Dear agents of the United States, Discovered by me yesterday in the 1999-2014 issues of the "List of Classes of United States Government Publications Available for Selection by Depository Libraries" (authored by the "Library Technical Services" "Superintendent of Documents" "U.S. Government Printing Office") is a Federal publication that is titled "Opinions of the Office of Legal Counsel" (Opinions) and assigned SuDocs J 1.5/4:. Such issues inform me the Opinions are only available in (P) format. At the Federal Regional Depository Library incorporated with the Merril-Cazier Library on the campus of the land-grant college titled Utah State University (FRDL-UT), I discovered that the 1997-2014 Opinions in (P) format were never distributed to the FRDL-UT for the free use and guidance of the public. Under 44 USC 1305, 5 USC 552(a)(1)(D) and 1 CFR 5.9(b), is it the intention of the "Public Printer/"Director of the Government Publishing Office" and of the Office if Legal Counsel to not print the 1997-2014 Opinions so they are not distributed to the FRDL-UT and, therefore, are not available for the free use and guidance of the public?
